Waterford railway station
(Plunkett Station) is located
across Rice Bridge on the
north side of the city
Waterford bus station is also
in the city located at

From here you can get a taxi

AV AND LIGHTING

We partner with an AV specialist who has environmental accreditation.

We select local suppliers to reduce miles travelled.

We turn off AV equipment when not in use.

We us natural daylight as much as possible and encourage clients to follow suit.

We use energy efficient lighting - all property bulbs are LED's.


We reuse, reduce and donate materials after use.


